## Volunteer Guardianship & Rep Payee

*Guardianship: Recruits/trains volunteers to serve as legal guardians for senior adults (age 60+) with serious health challenges (such as advanced dementia or chronic mental illness) and who have no family members able to act as one.*

*Representative Payee: Recruits/trains volunteers to help vulnerable senior adults manage social security benefits and pay monthly bills.*
